In 1848, The Company was founded in Chicago as a Midwest sales agency





In 1886, Joy Morton bought a major share of the company and renamed it, Joy Morton & Co.

In 1911, Morton added an anticaking agent to its salt and later developed the slogan, "When It Rains It Pours". In 1924 Morton Salt introduced lodized Salt nationwide.
