The Main Entrees were paired with the Mercer, Cabernet Sauvignon, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington and brought deep oaky flavors with toasted notes that paired perfectly with each of the three entrée choices.



Finally, a delightful end to a beautiful meal, we were presented with a Zardetto, Prosecco Brut, Italy with a decadent but airy tiramisu. The bubbles were a charming and refreshing play, and the light fruity flavors capped the night off perfectly.



With each course, the Chicago IFT paid homage to the Past, Present and Future of the section with a grand toast and short movie from an esteemed Toast Master. The Past was presented by Past-Chair Dan Best, and commemorated our long history as we toured dinner meetings from each decade - it was remarkable to see how new technologies emerged through the years, and how some topics are recurring throughout time.
