A. Compliance & Regulatory Analyst: Responsibilities include reviewing new formulations for regulatory and labeling compliance, provide guidance to manufacturing on blending or restrictions on blending, facilitate handling customer application complaints, provide support to purchasing for Vendor Management Program, participate in cGMP, and participate in food safety programs. Position is located in Sycamore, IL. Requirements: Bachelor's degree in Chemistry or Microbiology, 3 – 5 years Quality or Food Safety experience. Working knowledge of SAP.

B. Food Technologist: Product development. Requirements: BS in Food Science, minimum 2 years (food manufacturing experience preferred). Culinary experience preferred.

C. Sr. Quality Systems Analyst: Reviews supplier documentation for adherence to established standards, and develops and maintains internal raw material specifications. Collaborates with Purchasing and Regulatory groups, collaborate with suppliers to establish meaningful raw material specifications and develops and maintains raw material specification templates used to guide the development of new and updated raw material specifications. Requirements: Bachelor's degree in Science or Engineering. Minimum 6 years of Quality Systems experience.



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D. Food Scientist (Medina, OH): Responsible for developing complex formulas, processing procedures and specifications for new products, product enhancement and cost reduction projects within a USDA facility. Requirements: B.S. degree in Food Science. Advanced degree preferred or a Culinary degree with a strong technical/product development background.

E. Regulatory Specialist: Provide regulatory support and expertise both internally and externally with clients to support the overall business strategy of the organization. Requirements: B.S. degree in Food Science or related field from a 4 year institution. 3 – 5 years Food Regulatory experience.

F. Sr. Manager, Supplier Food Safety (Bentonville, AR): Responsible for approving or disapproving the types of foods and food suppliers they are assigned to oversee by reviewing supplier's practices and results of third party audits, certifications and product test results. Requirements: B.S. in Food Microbiology, Food Science or related field. Beneficial Registrations or certifications include: Registered Microbiologist, Certified Food Safety Professional. Graduate degree in Food Science or related field is desirable.

G. FOOD SCIENTIST-INTERNATIONAL: Global leader in food ingredients seeks Food Scientist at their International R&D department in Chicago. Responsibilities include formulating batter & breading products for use in food production and in restaurants, presenting product concepts to customers, working with production and Q.C. to meet customer specifications and commercialization. 10 – 20% travel. Requirements: BS/MS Food Science or related. Min. 5 years experience in product development.

H. ASSOCIATE FOOD SCIENTIST: Global leader in food ingredients seeks Associate Food Scientist at their Chicago headquarters. Responsibilities include formulating batter & breading products and bakery mixes for use in food production and in restaurants, supporting customer presentations and conducting analytical testing. Requirements: BS/MS Food Science or related. 0 – 3 years product development experience.

I. FOOD SCIENTIST: Global leader in food ingredients seeks Associate Food Scientist at their Chicago headquarters. Responsibilities include formulating batter & breading products and bakery mixes for use in food production and in restaurants, presenting product concepts to customers, working with production and QC to meet customer specifications and commercialization. Requirements: BS/MS Food Science or related. 0 – 3 years product development experience.

J. QUALITY ASSURANCE SPECIALIST: Private label manufacturer of canned foods, flavor bases and spice blends for the foodservice industry. Bachelor Degree in Food Science is preferred or a Bachelor Science Degree (Chemistry, Biology). Must have 3 – 5 yrs professional



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experience in quality management or quality system discipline. An understanding of global regulatory requirements and working knowledge of USDA and FDA requirements.
